Cosmetic dental discounts

Effective January 1, 2026, your BlueMedicare plan will also include a 20% discount on dental services your Medicare Advantage plan doesn't cover.¹ So, if your teeth are discolored, worn, chipped, or broken, you'll be able to enjoy extra savings on cosmetic dental procedures that can help improve the appearance of your smile. The discount applies to the following general or restorative services:

- Cosmetic contouring
- Laminate veneer (porcelain or composite)
- Whitening
- Implant/abutment/crown



BlueMedicare Premier's \$3,500 dental allowance gives you the freedom to get the dental care you need. Your benefits go even further because we negotiate significant discounts with dentists in our network.

We've got you covered

The chart below lists several services covered by the BlueMedicare Premier plan. It shows the significant savings on dental services you may use throughout the year. Because of the deep discounts offered by our network providers, the amount charged to your plan ("dental allowance deduction") is a fraction of the market rate. In the scenario below, your plan's allowance would easily cover the services you need, with no out-of-pocket cost. These discounts still apply, even if you exhaust your plan's annual allowance.

Oral Health for Overall Health

BlueMedicare Premier also includes Oral Health for Overall HealthSM. These benefits are available at no extra cost when you visit an in-network dentist.

The 20% discount does not apply if coverage for implants is included in your dental benefit plan.
